Trip Ellis' Pro Soccer School is designed to focus on proper soccer techniques in a fun, confidence building, and creative environment tailored to challenge players of all ages and ability levels.

RECREATIONAL PLAYERS CAMP

The **Recreational Camp** is for boys and girls ages 5-14. It is designed for less experienced players who need to focus on basic soccer techniques. This camp is set in a relaxed, fun and creative environment to help develop excitement & passion for the game.



ADVANCED PLAYERS CAMP

The **Advanced Camp** is for boys and girls ages 8-16. This camp is for players who have travel team or school team playing experience. It will focus on technical ball skills, tactical concepts, and awareness. Players will concentrate on proper techniques and focus on when and how to apply these techniques to game situations. Passing, dribbling, moves to beat players and change direction, receiving, turning, heading, & shooting will all be covered.



SHOOTING/GOAL-KEEPER CAMP

The **Shooting & Goal-Keeper Camp** is for boys and girls ages 8-16 who are seeking position specific training. This camp will focus on proper shooting techniques for field players. Topics will include shooting for power, accuracy, bending, volleying, heading, and breakaways.



The emphasis for Goal-Keepers will be on



proper catching, shot-stopping, diving, positioning, breakaways, crossed balls, distribution, punching techniques, & communication. At the end of each day both

groups (Shooters & Keepers) will be combined to work on the techniques learned and will be put into game-like pressure situations.
